Statement of Faith of Project Paraguay

The articles of incorporation of Project Paraguay state that its mission is to "promote the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the application of biblical standards of conduct in all other areas of Paraguayan life." Para. 3.3.

First and foremost, Project Paraguay considers the Nicene Creed as the basic encapsulation of what we believe as Christians. The Nicene Creed states,

I BELIEVE in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, And of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, Begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, Very God of very God, Begotten, not made, Being of one substance with the Father, By whom all things were made: Who for us men, and for our salvation, came down from heaven, And was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the Virgin Mary, And was made man; And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried; And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures, And ascended into heaven, And sitteth on the right hand of the Father. And he shall come again with glory to judge both the quick and the dead: Whose kingdom shall have no end.

And I believe in the Holy Ghost, The Lord and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son, Who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified, Who spake by the Prophets. And I believe one Holy catholic and Apostolic Church. I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins. And I look for the Resurrection of the dead, And the Life of the world to come. Amen

Secondly, Project Paraguay considers the Reformation and the rejection of doctrinal impurities that had arisen in the Medieval Roman Church as essential to the continued survival and growth of a vibrant and God-honoring Christianity. As such, Project Paraguay generally accepts the major Confessions that arose out of the Reformation such as:

The Gallican Confession, The Belgic Confession, The Heidelberg Catechism, The Thirty-Nine Articles, The Second Helvetic Confession, The Canons of Dort, The Westminster Confession of Faith, The London Confession of 1689, and The Savoy Declaration.
